

Parent Code of Conduct

1. I COMMIT TO MAKING SURE MY CHILD ARRIVES AT PRACTICES ON TIME AND IS PREPARED

This means often arriving early so that my child has enough time to get their equipment ready prior to joining our practice.

2. I WILL SHOW RESPECT FOR THE REFEREES

They may make the wrong call, but the job of the referee is not an easy one. Voicing my displeasure will not improve the situation.

3. I WILL ALLOW COACHES TO COACH DURING GAMES

While this is not easy, I know that providing potentially conflicting messages during a game can be confusing to my child and my presence on the field may contribute negatively to their ability to focus.

4. I WILL BE A ROLE MODEL FOR MY CHILD REGARDING GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP & TEAMWORK

These things start with adults, and the players look up to us to lead by example. We will take pride in how we carry ourselves and treat others.

5. I WILL RESPECT THE OPPOSING TEAM, COACHES, AND FANS

They are the same as us in many ways, but they simply wear different uniforms. Appreciation for their performance and respect for their abilities will contribute to a positive game environment.

6. I WILL SUPPORT MY TEAM'S COACHES

I know that coaching isn't easy. It's a significant contribution of time and energy. While I may not agree with the coach at all times, I also understand that contradicting the coach's message is counterproductive. If I have concerns, I will schedule a time with the coach to calmly and constructively discuss lineup and playing time rather than during, immediately before, or after a practice or game.

7. I WILL DO MY PART TO CONTRIBUTE TO THIS FOOTBALL FAMILY!

I will do everything within my control to make this a positive experience for my child, other players, families and coaches.
